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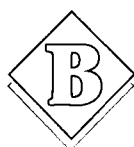
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Basic Understandings — The Teacher

The successful teacher must know and practice the three characteristics of an effective teacher.

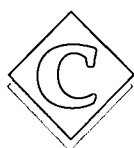
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First Characteristic — Positive Expectations

The effective teacher has positive expectations for student success.

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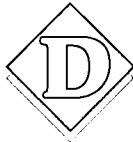


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
